Parent's Code of Conduct Policy

As a parent or guardian of a Northwest FC player, you agree to follow the Code of Conduct as listed below. You agree to have your player(s), and any spectator(s) with you, follow the same Code of Conduct. You understand that your behavior, positive and/or negative, affects the image of Northwest FC.

Respect the game, including your child, his or her teammates, and opponents.

This means ensuring that your child attends and comes prepared for all practices and games and treats both teammates and opponents with dignity and respect. Good sportsmanship means playing fair and safe, controlling negative emotions, and keeping the spirit of competition a healthy endeavor.

Respect the officials.

Referees are an important part of the game. It is expected that participants and spectators will respect all officials. You will not approach a referee before, during, or after a game. You may email the coach and Northwest FC Director of Coaching (DOC) with any concerns, issues, and/or complaints about how a game was handled. The DOC will then investigate and take proper action.

Refrain from coarse and threatening language, as well as all forms of physical aggression.

You will not verbally or physically assault a referee, other spectator, coach or participant before, during or after a game. You may email the coach and DOC to express your concerns 48 hours after the game.

Sideline Coaching

You, or any spectators, are not to coach players of either team during a game. This causes confusion for the player and frustration for the coaches. You may discuss your concerns with the coach and/or the DOC 48 hours after the game.

Safety of the players, including physical and emotional dangers.

Pay attention to injuries, including concussions, and respond to them in a timely manner. Additionally, pay attention to signs of youth sport burnout and be sure to respond to your child if he or she needs help.

Positive Sideline Support

You will encourage the players and game through positive language and manners. There is zero tolerance for any negative behavior, physical or verbal, to any participant, coach, or spectator from either team.
